

## PRIVACY SETTINGS FOR THE NEW INFOFOUP CATALOG, POWERED BY BIBLIOCOMMONS

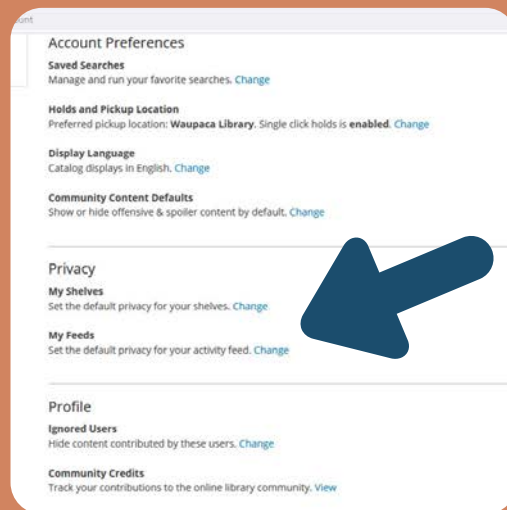
The new catalog has some great social features for people who want to connect with other readers. However, not everyone wants to participate, and some would rather keep their reading activities private. The good news is that **YOU** have control over what gets shared with others.



### To view your privacy settings

1. Log in to your account.
2. On the menu, click My Settings.
3. On the My Settings page, look for the Privacy section.
4. Set your default privacy settings for your Shelves and Feeds.

Regardless of your default shelf setting, you can always make individual items private or shared.



Shelf privacy settings allow you to control whether or not items you add to these shelves are visible to other library users by default. If these settings are off, anything you add is shared—visible to others. If you plan to add ratings or comments to things you've borrowed, you should make them shared. Otherwise, no one else will be able to see what you've contributed.



Your activity feed records your interactions with items in the catalog, and with content created by other library users. It shows items you add to your shelves, lists you create, comments and ratings and lists or comments by others that you like.
