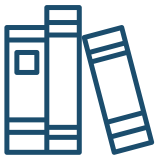


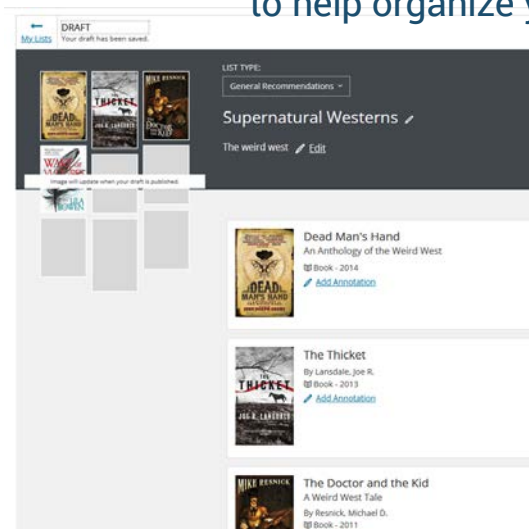
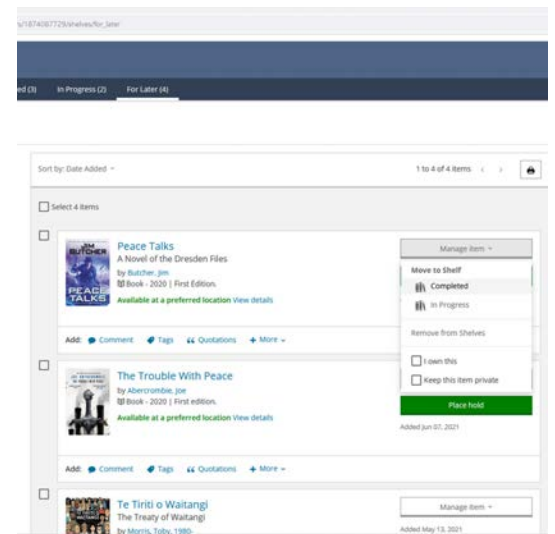
READING HISTORY, LISTS & SHELVES

The new catalog offers two ways to keep track of books and other items you're interested in: **Shelves and Lists**. These new features are similar to reading lists in the old catalog, but with more flexibility. Unfortunately, we cannot directly import reading lists from the old catalog to the new. The good news is that you will continue to be able to access your reading lists on the old catalog, it isn't going away.



SHELVES

- Easily track items using 3 categories (For Later, In Progress, Completed)
- You can choose to share your shelves with other library users or keep them private
- You can move an item from one shelf to another
- Use catalog filters and create personal tags to help organize your items



LISTS



- Collection of titles related to a topic or idea of your choosing
- You can create as many lists as you like, add items, and give them a description
- When you're saving a list, you can choose to make it public or private
- Share your lists online with a link
